

Asuhan Keperawatan Pada An “G” Dengan Dengue Hemoragic Fever di RSD Balung Kabupaten Jember

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Abstract

Hemorhagic Fever (DHF) fever is a viral disease (arbovirus) that enters the body through the bite of Aedes Aegypti mosquito. The fever that occurs due to this disease is sudden and lasts for 5-7 days. Usually looks lethargic, decreased appetite, headache, pain in the eyeball area, back, and joints. Also appear red spots on the body (petechiae), especially in the face and chest. Advanced symptoms that occur is the emergence of skin wrinkles on the forehead, stomach, arms, thighs, and other body parts (Suriadi & Yuliani, 2010).
