

GAMBARAN PERILAKU SEKSUAL REMAJA DI SEKOLAH YANG MENERAPKAN SISTEM *NON CO-EDUCATION*

Penerapan sistem pendidikan *non co-education*, yaitu memisahkan siswa-siswi sepanjang aktivitas di sekolah mulai banyak diterapkan oleh sekolah. Walaupun dipisah namun mereka masih dapat bertemu di luar jam sekolah dengan lawan jenis bahkan masih ada saja yang melakukan perilaku seksual dengan pacarnya. Oleh karena itu, penelitian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui gambaran tentang perilaku seksual remaja di sekolah yang menerapkan sistem *non co-education*.

Jenis penelitian ini adalah kuantitatif deskriptif dengan populasi siswa-siswi SMK Baitul Hikmah yang menerapkan sistem *non co-education* yaitu sebanyak 700 siswa, dengan jumlah sampel sebanyak 379 siswa yang terdiri dari 190 siswa laki-laki dan 189 siswa perempuan yang diambil dengan teknik *purposif sampling* yaitu yang memiliki karakteristik pernah atau sedang menjalani hubungan pacaran. Metode pengumpulan data dilakukan dengan menggunakan skala perilaku seksual dan dianalisis menggunakan analisis deskriptif persentase.

Hasil penelitian diperoleh bahwa terdapat sekitar 16.1% remaja di sekolah *non co-education* memiliki resiko dan kecenderungan untuk pernah melakukan perilaku seksual dengan pacarnya. Bentuk perilaku seksual yang muncul yaitu *touching, kissing, necking, petting*, dan *intercourse*. Dari kelima bentuk perilaku seksual tersebut yang memiliki persentase paling tinggi muncul adalah *necking*, yaitu sekitar 19.3% remaja di sekolah *non co-education* memiliki resiko dan kecenderungan tinggi untuk pernah melakukan perilaku seksual dalam bentuk *necking* dengan pacarnya. Jika dibandingkan antara remaja laki-laki dan perempuan didapatkan hasil bahwa remaja laki-laki memiliki persentase lebih tinggi dibandingkan remaja perempuan dalam resiko dan kecenderungan untuk pernah melakukan perilaku seksual dengan pacarnya, yaitu sekitar 17.9% sedangkan remaja perempuan sekitar 14.8%.

DESCRIPTION OF ADOLESCENT SEXUAL BEHAVIOR IN SCHOOL THAT APPLYING SYSTEM NON CO-EDUCATION

ABSTRACT

Implementation system of non co-education, which separates the students throughout the school activities started many adopted by the school. Although separated but they are still able to meet outside school hours with the opposite sex even there are still sexual behavior with his girlfriend or her boyfriend. Therefore, this study aims to find a picture of adolescent sexual behavior in the schools with a system of non co-education.

This research is a quantitative descriptive with a population of SMK Baitul Hikmah which introduced a system of non co-education even as many as 700 students, with a total sample of 379 students consisting of 190 male students and 189 female students were taken by techniques purposive sampling that have been or are undergoing characteristics dating relationships. Methods of data collection is done by using a scale of sexual behavior and were analyzed using descriptive analysis of the percentage.

Results showed that there were approximately 16.1% of adolescents in schools non co-education at risk and a tendency to ever perform sexual behavior with his girlfriend or her boyfriend. Forms of sexual behavior that arise are touching, kissing, necking, petting, and intercourse. Of the five forms of sexual behavior that has emerged is the highest percentage of necking, which is about 19.3% of adolescents in schools non co-education have a high risk and a tendency to ever perform sexual behavior in the form of necking with her boyfriend or his girlfriend. If the comparison between boys and girls showed that adolescent males have a higher percentage compared to adolescent girls at risk and a tendency to ever perform sexual behavior with his girlfriend, which is about 17.9% and about 14.8% of female students.
