

ABSTRACT

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Filling In Inpatient Medical Record Documents At Madya Accredited Health Centers In Jember Regency

The completeness of filling out medical record documents plays an important role in improving the quality of public health center. This study aims to identify the filling of medical record documents at the Madya Accredited Health Center in Jember Regency. The research uses a quantitative approach with an analytical descriptive study design. The method of data collection was carried out by questionnaires using google drive media which were given to nurses who worked in the scope of the Madya Accredited Health Center in Jember Regency. The population and sample in this study were 91 nurses who served in 20 Madya Accredited Health Centers in Jember Regency. The results of medical record research from inpatient medical records from the knowledge variable about medical records are good: 75% good, the statement agrees that filling out medical records as a workload: 84%, the implementation of SOPs in filling out medical records has been carried out: 69%, the statement agrees about additional incentives: 71%, statements agree on the importance of leadership motivation: 98%, statements agree on punishment: 88% and medical recaps of medical records of patients in inpatient Puskesmas Accredited Madya. At the Jember District Health Center by 75%. Policies and motivation are needed in increasing the completeness of filling in inpatient medical records.
