ABSTRACT

Key Word: Vocabulary Achievement, Active Participation, Spidergrams

This research was a classroom action research focusing on the use of Spidergrams to improve the eight grade students' vocabulary achievement. The subjects of this research were the students of the school had experienced difficulties to memorize and understand vocabulary, especially VIII-F class. This class had difficulties in learning vocabulary. it can be seen from the mean score of the vocabulary test was 57.72. And it showed that there were only 9 (31.03%) of the students had reached the standard score (75), while others 20 (68.96%) had failed.

In this research, the researcher uses Spidergrams in teaching vocabulary to the students to improve the VIII-F students' vocabulary achievement and active participation. Vocabulary achievement by using Spidergrams helps the students to enrich their vocabulary achievement. From the observation of the students active participation was done during the teaching learning process of vocabulary by using Spidergrams in Cycle 1, the result of the students' active participation was 75.86%. It means that the target of the students' active paticipation was achieved. To know the consistency of the result, the observation was continued to Cycle 2. The result of students' active participation increased from 75.86% in Cycle 1 to 89.65% in Cycle 2. The result of the students's active participation in this research proves that the use of Spidergrams in teaching vocabulary can improve the students' active participation during the teaching learning process of vocabulary.

Meanwhile, based on the students mean score of the achievement test in Cycle 1 is 76.06. There were 75.86% could achieve the target score (75). It means that the criterion of success in Cycle 1 was achieved. However, the action was still continued to Cycle 2 in order to improve from Cycle 1. In Cycle 2, it was found that the mean score of the students' vocabulary achievement test by Spidergrams improved from (76.06) in Cycle 1 to (80.13) in Cycle 2. There were 25 (86.20%) could achieve the target score and there were 4 (13.79%) couldn't achieve the target score. The percentage of vocabulary achievement were (75.86%) in cycle 1 and (86.20%) in cycle 2. It means that the target students' vocabulary score requirement in this research had been achieved.

Based on the result above, Spidergrams could improve students' vocabulary achievement and active participation of VIII-F at SMPN 01 Sukorambi in 2016/2017 academic year.
