We have received the review reports for your paper "Enhancing The Performance of Sentiment Analysis Task on Product Review by Handling Both Local and Global Context.".

We require now that you implement in your submission the following recommendations made by the reviewers:

#### Reviewer A Comments:

Suggestions which would improve the quality of the paper but are not essential for publication:

- 1. The mathematical expressions are not precise. For example, in Equation (2), index j is not defined. Also wsja ∈ wi is very confusing.
- 2. Since there are so many notations with indices, one would suggests that the author(s) provide a list of notations with definitions, in which the symbols for indices are distinct.
- 3. Acronyms need to be defined before being referred. For example, WSD is not defined, although one knows it stands for the Word Sense Disambiguation method.
- 4. One can easily point out the grammatical errors, such as "similarity like is presented in equation 7" in the paragraph before Equation 7, "Different with was done by..." in the following page.

Changes which must be made before publication:

- 1. The bad writing makes this paper awful to read, and the authors fail to convey the ideas of their study.
- 2.Each step in the proposed method needs more details of how it is done. For example, in the step of edge extraction, the similarity measure is crucial. One would like to see how it is calculated, and why the specific algorithm is chosen.
- 3. The authors need to explain the reason why the whole model is built, other than just picking up some techniques and methods.
- 4.The paper needs to provide its experimental design. Just looking at the results, one would have hard time to see how they are obtained. Is it a one time experiment for a data set? If so, the results are far from convincing. The author(s) need to provide more experiments on different data sets.

#### Reviewer B Comments:

Suggestions which would improve the quality of the paper but are not essential for publication:

The manuscript "Enhancing The Performance of Sentiment Analysis Task on Product Review by Handling Both Local and Global Context" addresses an age-old topic. Most of recent published papers related to Sentiment Analysis actually discussed about what you called "global context" while what you called "local context" could be similar to their basic steps. Literature review was insufficient.


