

# THE DESCRIPTION OF FORGIVENESS OF DIVORCE PEOPLE AT KUNIR DISTRICT LUMAJANG REGENCY

## ABSTRACT

This research aimed to explore the description of *forgiveness* of divorce people at district Lumajang regency. There were 51 persons as samples by incidental sampling and completed forgiveness scale (18 items;  $\alpha = .932$ ).

Result showed that there are 39 persons (76,47%) who had high *forgiveness* and 12 persons (23,52%) low *forgiveness*. Women tends more to *forgiveness* (43,13%) than men (33,33%). Based on level of education, people who educated in elementary school have high *forgiveness* (31,37% ) than who educated junior high school (29,41%) and senior high school (15,68%). Based on ethnic, javanese have high *forgiveness* (60,78%) than Madurese (15,68%). Based on length of marriage, people who marriage 1-10 years have high forgiveness (58,82%) than who marriage 10-21 years (17,64%). And based on length of divorce 1-6 (68,62%) more *forgiveness* than 7-12 (7,84). From factor of age, 21-27 old (39,21) more *forgiveness* than 16-20 old (37,25). Based on occupation, housewives have high *forgiveness* (29,41%) than woman's career (11,76%). Subjects who divorce caused by economic factor have high forgiveness (33,33%) than dishonesty factor (31,37). Subjects more forgiving another person and forgiving of a situation (68,62%) than forgiving one self (33,33%).
