### Abstrak

*Patient safety*, sangat diperlukan dalam upaya peningkatan mutu rumah sakit. Kepemimpinan memiliki dampak positif pada motivasi perawat dan meningkatkan tingkat keselamatan. Dukungan kepemimpinan yang tidak efektif tiga kali lebih mungkin untuk menerapkan *patient safety* yang buruk. Keberhasilan penerapan *patient safety* dalam keperawatan sangat didukung oleh peran dan fungsi manajer ruangan melalui fungsi *organizing* pelayanan keperawatan di ruang rawat inap, dalam hal tersebut peneliti tertarik untuk melakukan penelitian tentang hubungan fungsi *organizing* kepala Ruang dengan penerapan *patient safety* di Ruang Rawat Inap Rumah Sakit Tingkat III Baladhika Husada Jember. Penelitian ini menggunakan desain kolerasi dengan pendekatakan *cross sectional* yang bertujuan untuk melihat apakah ada hubungan antara fungsi *organizing* kepala ruang dengan penerapan *patient safety*. Populasi penelitian ini adalah perawat yang bekerja di Ruang Rawat Inap Rumah Sakit Tingkat III Baladhika Husada Jember dengan jumlah yaitu 74 perawat yang terdiri dari 18 lulusan D3 dan 56 lulusan Ners. Teknik pengambilan sampel menggunakan *propionate stratified random sampling*. Penilaian menggunakan kuisioner terkait fungsi *organizing* dan penerapan *patient safety*. Hasil penelitian dengan uji *Rank Spearman Rho* ( $\alpha = 0,05$ ) di dapatkan *p value* sebesar ( $p = 0,00$ ) yang berarti adanya hubungan bermakna antara fungsi *organizing* kepala ruang dengan penerapan *patient safety*. Kesimpulan penelitian ini bahwa terdapat hubungan yang signifikan antara fungsi *organizing* kepala ruang dengan penerapan *patient safety*.

### **Abstract**

*Patient safety is indispensable in efforts to improve hospital quality. Leadership has a positive impact on nurse motivation and improves safety rates. Ineffective leadership support is three times more likely to implement poor patient safety. The successful implementation of patient safety in nursing is strongly supported by the role and function of the room manager through the organizing function of nursing services in the inpatient room, in this case the researcher is interested in conducting research on the relationship between the organizing function of the head of the room with the implementation of patient safety in the Inpatient Room of Level III Baladhika Husada Jember Hospital. This study uses a correlation design with a cross sectional approach that aims to see if there is a relationship between the organizing function of the head of the room with the implementation of patient safety. The population of this study were nurses who worked in the Inpatient Room of Level III Baladhika Husada Jember Hospital with a total of 74 nurses consisting of 18 D3 graduates and 56 Ners graduates. The sampling technique used proportionate stratified random sampling. Assessment using questionnaires related to organizing functions and implementation of patient safety. The results of the study with the Spearman Rho Rank test ( $\alpha = 0.05$ ) obtained a  $p$  value of ( $p = 0.00$ ) which means that there is a significant relationship between the organizing function of the head of the room with the implementation of patient safety. The conclusion of this study is that there is a significant relationship between the organizing function of the head of the room and the implementation of patient safety.*
