

ABSTRAK

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Penelitian ini mengkaji aksesibilitas bagi tahanan penyandang disabilitas di ruang tahanan Polres Jember. Fokusnya adalah aksesibilitas bagi penyandang disabilitas belum sepenuhnya tersedia. Kajian ini bertujuan untuk mengetahui aksesibilitas bagi tahanan penyandang disabilitas di ruang tahanan Polres Jember. Penelitian yang digunakan adalah penelitian yuridis normatif, dengan pendekatan perundang-undangan dan konseptual, Masih terdapat perlakuan terhadap tahanan penyandang disabilitas yang belum sesuai dengan hak keadilan dan perlindungan hukum penyandang disabilitas yang terdapat dalam Pasal 9 UU Penyandang Disabilitas. Hal tersebut dapat dilihat dari belum terpenuhinya aksesibilitas pada ruang tahanan dalam Polres Jember. Berdasarkan Pasal 9 UU Penyandang Disabilitas yang mengatur terkait hak keadilan dan perlindungan hukum penyandang disabilitas yaitu salah satunya memperoleh penyediaan aksesibilitas dalam pelayanan peradilan.

ABSTRACT

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This study examines accessibility for prisoners with disabilities in the Jember Police detention cell. The focus is on accessibility for persons with disabilities that is not yet fully available. This study aims to determine accessibility for prisoners with disabilities in the Jember Police detention cell. The research used is normative juridical research, with a legislative and conceptual approach. There is still treatment of prisoners with disabilities that is not in accordance with the rights to justice and legal protection of persons with disabilities as stated in Article 9 of the Law on Persons with Disabilities. This can be seen from the unfulfilled accessibility in the detention cell in the Jember Police. Based on Article 9 of the Law on Persons with Disabilities which regulates the rights to justice and legal protection of persons with disabilities, one of which is obtaining the provision of accessibility in judicial services.
