Abstrak

Pendahuluan: *Caring* adalah sentral keperawatan yang menjelaskan kepedulian didasarkan pada seperangkat nilai-nilai kemanusiaan yang universal. Mobilisasi dini adalah pergerakan yang dilakukan sedini mungkin di tempat tidur yang berguna untuk membantu penyembuhan luka pada ibu *post sectio caesarea*. Jumlah persalinan SC di RSIA Srikandi IBI Jember 351 pasien dalam 3 bulan terakhir, yaitu pada bulan Februari-Maret 2019. Tujuan penelitian ini untuk mengidentifikasi hubungan perilaku *caring* petugas kesehatan dengan adaptasi mobilisasi dini *fase taking in* pada ibu *post section caesare* di RSIA Srikandi IBI Jember. **Desain Penelitian:** Penelitian ini menggunakan metode *corellation research* dengan pendekatan *cross sectional*. Populasi dalam penelitian ini adalah 91 ibu *post sectio caesarea*. Teknik pengambilan sampel *consecutive sampling* alat ukur yang digunakan yaitu lembar kuisioner. Anlisis data menggunakan uji *Chi-Square*. **Hasil penelitian:** Didapatkan hasil *p value* $0,000 < (\alpha 0,05)$ yang berarti ada hubungan perilaku *caring* petugas kesehatan dengan adaptasi mobilisasi dini *fase taking in* pada ibu *post section caesare* di RSIA Srikandi IBI Jember. **Diskusi:** Rekomendasi penelitian ini adalah bagi ibu *post sectio caesarea* untuk lebih aktif dalam mencari informasi kepada petugas kesehatan tentang adaptasi mobilisasi dini.

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The relationship of caring behaviors of health workers with the adaptation of early mobilization of the taking-in phase in post Caesarea mothers at RSIA Srikandi IBI Jember

Abstract

Introduction: *Caring is central to nursing, explaining care is based on a set of universal human values (kindness, caring, and self-love and others). Early mobilization is movement that is carried out as early as possible in bed by training body parts to stretch which is useful to help wound healing in post sectio caesarean mothers. The number of SC deliveries in Indonesia reaches around 30-80% of the total deliveries. The purpose of this study was to identify the relationship of caring behaviors of health workers with the adaptation of early mobilization of the taking-in phase in post-caesarean mothers in RSIA Srikandi IBI Jember. Method:* This research uses corellation research method with cross sectional approach. The population in this study was 91 post sectio caesarean mothers. The sampling technique uses consecutive sampling while the data collection technique uses questionnaire sheets. Data analysis using Chi-Square test. **Result:** The results obtained p value $0,000 < (\alpha 0.05)$, which means that there is a relationship between caring behavior of health workers with the adaptation of early mobilization of the taking-in phase in Caesarean post-section mothers at RSIA Srikandi IBI Jember. **Discussion:** The recommendation of this study is for post sectio caesarean mothers to be more active in finding information to health workers about early mobilization adaptation.
