

Narrative is a type of text that is proposed to amuse and to deal with actual and vicarious experience and different ways, narrative also deal with problematic event which lead to a crisis or turning points of some kind, which in turn find a resolution. Narrative text has some characteristics, they are generic structure and language features. The detail explanation as follows:

• Generic structure

- a. Orientation : introducing the character of the story, the time and pace of the story (who, what, when and where)
- b. Complication : when the problem in the story develop
- c. Resolution : where the problem in the story is solved
- d. Reorientation : it consist of moral lesson, advice or teaching from the writer

• Language feature

- a. Using part action verb : climbed, turned etc.
- b. Using specific noun as pronoun of person animal in the story example: the king, the queen, etc.

- c. Using adjectives which are for noun phrase, example: long black hair, two red apples, etc.
- d. Using time connectives and Conjunctions to arrange the events. Examples: Then, before, after, soon, etc.
- e. Using adverbs and adverbial phrase to show the location of events. Examples: Here, in the mountain, ever after, etc.
- f. Using dialogue to elicit an emotional response from the reader
- g. Using past tense
- h. Using of variety of simple, compound and complex sentences



Definition and the purpose of Narrative text

Narrative is a type of text that is proposed to amuse and to deal with actual and vicarious experience and different ways, narrative also deal with problematic event which lead to a crisis or turning points of some kind, which in turn find a resolution. Narrative text has some characteristics, they are generic structure and language features. The detail explanation as follows:

• Generic structure

- a. Orientation : introducing the character of the story, the time and pace of the story (who, what, when and where)
- b. Complication : when the problem in the story develop
- c. Resolution : where the problem in the story is solved
- d. Reorientation : it consist of moral lesson, advice or teaching from the writer

• Language feature

- a. Using part action verb : climbed, turned etc.
- b. Using specific noun as pronoun of person animal in the story example: the king, the queen, etc.
- c. Using adjectives which are for noun phrase, example: long black hair, two red apples, etc.
- d. Using time connectives and Conjunctions to arrange the events. Examples: Then, before, after, soon, etc.
- e. Using adverbs and adverbial phrase to show the location of events. Examples: Here, in the mountain, ever after, etc.
- f. Using dialogue to elicit an emotional response from the reader
- g. Using past tense
- h. Using of variety of simple, compound and complex sentences
