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PT Astra Agro Lestari Tbk (AAL), a palm oil company, is dedicated to implementing a sustainable innovation program to foster long-term business growth.

Santosa, the President Director of Astra Agro Lestari, stated that the company has a longstanding commitment to sustainable practices directly linked to its operations. "Our commitment to sustainability has been evident since 2015 with the introduction of the NDPE policy, which was further strengthened in 2022 through the Astra Agro Sustainability Aspiration 2030 initiative. We are consistently implementing these programs, and many initiatives have already met their targets within just two years," he said on Sunday, December 15, 2024.

Furthermore, the company is undergoing a digital transformation in its operations. One key element is the SSKA 2.0 information system, launched last year to streamline third-party fresh fruit bunch (FFB) transactions. This initiative aims to enhance transparency and efficiency in the business.

PepsiCo, FrieslandCampina suspend palm oil sourcing from Astra Agro Lestari

PepsiCo and FrieslandCampina have suspended imports from Astra Agro Lestari (AAL), Indonesia's second-largest palm oil company, following an investigation into environmental and human rights violations committed in Central and West Sulawesi, Indonesia. The US and Dutch multinationals are the latest in a long line of consumer brands to cut ties with the company.

PepsiCo has notified the US Friends of the Earth that the company has suspended palm oil imports from five factories in connection with AAL. FrieslandCampina has also suspended all AAL procurement and is encouraging other companies to do the same.

Both companies join six other major consumer goods companies in cutting ties with AAL, including Hershey's, Nestle, and Procter & Gamble.

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PT Astra Agro Lestari Tbk, or Astra Agro ("the Company"), is one of the initiators of the Indonesian palm oil industry. It was established on October 3, 1988, under the name PT Suryaraya Cakrawala, but the Company changed its name to PT Astra Agro Niaga in 1989. The Company, a subsidiary of PT Astra International Tbk (Astra), has also been in the business of managing tea and cocoa plantations in Central Java since 1990, and now the Company has focused on oil palm plantations.

To ensure business continuity, the Company regularly conducts replanting programs across all Astra Agro plantations to renew crops and enhance future palm oil yields. Currently, Astra Agro manages a total plantation area of 284,831 hectares, located all over the islands of Sumatra, Kalimantan, and Sulawesi. This area comprises 212,602 hectares of nucleus plantations and 72,229 hectares of plasma plantations.

In line with the Company's mission to contribute to national development and prosperity, within 2022, the Company strengthened its commitment to sustainable governance by introducing the Astra Agro Sustainability Aspirations 2030 initiative. This initiative aligns with the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) and adheres to the principles of Environment, Social, and Governance (ESG). The Astra Agro Sustainability Aspirations 2030 is the Company's strategy, implemented through 12 initiatives under the Triple-P Road Map: Portfolio, People, and Public Contribution, with Good Corporate Governance (GCG) as the key enabler.

Astra Agro was one of the first companies to obtain Indonesian Sustainable Palm Oil (ISPO) certification in 2012 through one of its subsidiaries. This achievement demonstrates the Company's efforts to meet sustainable palm oil plantation standards. To date, most of the Company's subsidiaries have obtained ISPO certification. Furthermore, several subsidiaries have also received International Sustainability and Carbon Certification (ISCC), demonstrating the Company's commitment to strengthening sustainability.
